



***CONFEDERATION CUP 2009 Edition***  
***June 6th & 7th 2009***

**Capital United Soccer Club** cordially extends a personal invitation to you and your club to participate in its 4<sup>th</sup> edition of the Boys' **Mini World Cup Tournament – Confederation Cup 2009 Edition to be held in Ottawa on June 6th and 7th**, at the Millennium Soccer Fields.

This inter-provincial tournament is open to boys' teams as specified on the application form.

Consistent with our thematic approach to this tournament, this year each team will represent one of the nations scheduled to take part in the **Confederation Cup 2009**. There will be a total of 16 teams accepted, per age group, U10 and U11.

The tournament will offer top-notch competition in the U10 and U11 age category (born on or after January 1, 1998 and January 1, 1999). Ontario Soccer Association (OSA) Level 5 League Premier & 1<sup>st</sup> Division teams (and equivalent levels in other provinces and countries, for example "AA" & "A" in Quebec) will be given preference to compete in the tournament.

The U-10 and U-11 Boys mini-soccer play 7 a-side games, and are allowed a maximum of 14 players on their roster. A maximum of 3 guest players is allowed.

Each team will be issued a set of jerseys as a keepsake of this unique soccer tournament experience. All teams and coaches will be honored in the official opening ceremonies within the "parade of athletes". This year, we anticipate over 2000 spectators in attendance. In addition, our media partners will also be providing media coverage of all aspects of the **Mini World Cup – Confederation Cup 2009 Edition**.

The two-day event guarantees each team a minimum of 4 games. All players must have individual identification (current association, provincial player's book or EODSA ID card). Teams must be registered with their District Association. All teams that are traveling outside of their district to attend the tournament will be required to provide proof of Permission to travel from their District Association. This travel permit must be submitted 7 days prior to the start of the Tournament. Participating teams are also required to provide proof of Medical Insurance Coverage for all players and team officials (usually included with player/coach).

The Mini World Cup Tournament Series has quickly become a well attended event. We would encourage you to register early as we anticipate the tournament to reach its registration capacity within a very short period of time.





Your entry fee of \$495.00 (no post dated cheques) must accompany each team's application. All cheques are to be made payable to "Capital United Soccer Club – Mini World Cup Tournament Series". **Closing date for applications is May 01, 2009.**

All cancellations must be in writing and any team canceling after May 01, 2009 shall forfeit all monies to Capital United Soccer Club – Mini World Cup Tournament Series
